Virginia State Simulation Alliance (VASSA) Conflict of Interest (COI) Policy

Purpose

To maintain the integrity of all activities conducted by VASSA

Procedure

- 1. Members are required to disclose any perceived or potential conflicts of interest.
- 2. Conference planning committee members are required to review relevant continuing education policies to verify guidelines associated with continuing education events, including VASSA's COI Policy
- 3. Presenters are required to disclose (orally or in writing) any conflicts of interests at the beginning of the presentation.
- 4. Conference attendees will be informed of requirements associated with successful completion of educational activities. That is, they will be informed of:
 - a. Learning outcomes or objectives prior to the educational activity; and
 - b. Criteria used to determine successful completion to earn continuing education credits (e.g., required attendance at an activity, completion of evaluation form)
- 5. Board members are required to review and approve resolution of any identified conflicts of interest.
- 6. All commercial support for educational activities is disclosed to conference participants.
- 7. Vendor workshops are educational offerings focused on troubleshooting, maintenance, and/or application of software that will support participants' simulation initiative(s). During the education workshop, presenters must not advertise or promote their company's product(s) for sale.
